Course assessments

Candidates **do not** have to sit a formal examination for the **Appointed Persons Emergency First Aid course**. However they must be able to satisfy the trainer that they can accurately demonstrate the skills they have been taught.

Course timings

The course has been designed to be undertaken in one 8 hour day. This can be delivered on weekdays or at weekends.

Course certification

Once the candidate has been signed off by the trainer they will receive an **HSE Approved certificate**. (Certificates normally take 2-3 weeks to be issued).

Course group booking cost

£692.00 + VAT (maximum of 16 candidates)
