How to book a place on a course

To book a place on the course all you need to do is pay for it. You can do that with one of the three following options.

Option 1: Book online via our secure website www.dsto.co.uk and pay by debit/credit card.

Option 2: Call our office on (01202) 299982 or Free phone 0800 652 9965 and pay by credit/debit card.

Option 3: We can give you our bank details and you pay the cash directly into our bank account via your local bank.

Once you have paid for the course, it confirms your place and we will send you a map and set of joining instructions via e-mail.

The training

To obtain the SIA Security Guard licence you will need to pass a qualification such as the **Level 2 Award in Security Guarding**. This will involve attending a 3 day course and passing three multiple choice exams. You will also need to provide suitable identification and pass a criminality check.

The course is separated into three Modules:

DAY 1: 09:30 – 17:00

Module 1: Working in the Private Security Industry

There is a 25 question multiple choice examination on Working in the Private Security Industry. The examination will last for 40 minutes and candidates will be required to correctly answer 18 out of the 25 questions.

DAY 2: 09:30 – 17:30

Module 2: Conflict Management for the Private Security Industry

There is a 25 question multiple choice examination on Conflict Management for the Private Security Industry. The examination will last for 40 minutes and candidates will be required to correctly answer 18 out of the 25 questions.

DAY 3: 09:30 – 17:00

Module 3: Working as a Security Guard

There is a 40 question multiple choice examination on Working as a Security Guard. The examination will last for 60 minutes and candidates will be required to correctly answer 28 out of the 40 questions.

Once you have completed your training

Applying for the SIA Door Supervisor licence

On receipt of your exam results, which should generally be **available within ten working days** of completing the course, you can send in your application form to the SIA (**provided that you have passed the exams**). The quickest and most effective method of applying for your SIA licence is online via the [SIA Website](#)

Once you have completed and printed the online application form, simply attach a countersigned photograph of yourself and send in your application together with the required identification documents and payment of £245.00.

Broadly speaking you should allow **about six weeks** for the SIA to process your application.

You can track how your application is proceeding by going to the Application Status checker on the SIA website.
