Funding eligibility

Either: UK nationals residing in England.

Or: Non-EU citizens with proof to remain in England for a minimum of 3 years.

To be eligible for funding you must **not** currently hold a **Level 1 literacy** qualification.

NB. Unfortunately we cannot fund people on a student visa.

Terror Threat Awareness

With the recent Terror Alert Status in the UK rising to "**SEVERE**", terrorism awareness and prevention, coupled with training is becoming **ever more vital**. We all have a part to play in ensuring that our businesses and working environments can continue to operate with a **greater degree of safety**.

This **course** has been **specifically created** to help meet this need and allow individuals and organisations to better understand their role and what steps they can take in the **fight against terror**.

HSE Approved Appointed Persons Emergency First Aid

This **Heath & Safety Executive** approved, Appointed Persons Emergency First Aid course has been designed specifically for those who operate within the **security industry**.

The course meets all the requirements of the **HSE** Appointed Persons qualification and successful candidates will receive an **EFA Certificate** which is valid for 3 years.

Programme breakdown

This 19 hour programme consists of 4 parts:

- Enrolment
- Pre study
- Terror Threat Awareness (TTA) course
- Appointed Person First Aid course

Enrolment (1 hour)

To take place approx 3 weeks prior to the course. During enrolment candidates will complete registration paperwork, needed to secure our funding, and complete an entry level basic skills test. All delegates will be registered with **SFS** (Skills for Security)

Candidates will be briefed about the **Terror Threat course**, given a breakdown of the content and instruction on how to complete the pre study work.

Pre study (4 hours)

The day after the enrolment, candidates will be e-mailed the TTA pre study work document.

To comply with the TTA course requirements on Guided Learning Hours, candidates should spend a **minimum of 4 hours** of pre course study in the lead up to the actual TTA course. This will enable them to gain a fairly comprehensive understanding of all the subjects covered on the programme before participation.

Terror Threat Awareness course (6 hours)

Each of our few selected trainers are **former members of the Special Forces** and have spent many years serving in conflict countries where terrorism is most prevalent, such as Iraq and Afghanistan.

A key part of the training focuses on examining the **history of terrorism**, as well as the factors that drive people to resort to **terrorist activity**.

The training also examines the steps an individual or organisation can take to attempt to **identify the level of threat they might be facing**, and explores what steps can be undertaken to counteract and **reduce this threat**.

Appointed Person First Aid course (8 hours)

This course provides candidates with a range of knowledge and practical skills for dealing with the most common scenarios involving **First Aid incidents in pubs and clubs**.

Programme contents

Throughout the Terror Threat Awareness course we will examine the following subjects:

- The definition of the terms '**Terrorism**' and '**Terrorist**'
- The history of terrorism and its effects
- What is an **Improvised Explosive Device**
- Different types of explosive devices and methods terrorists employ
- Counter terror organisations
- Contingency and emergency planning
- **Threat assessment** and management
- Risk reduction measures to **reduce the threat** you face
- The importance of incident management planning
- **Post attack** or incident considerations

Throughout the First Aid course we will examine the following subjects:

- Causes of Unconsciousness
- Scene Management
- CPR (Basic Life Support)
- Adult Resuscitation
- Recovery Position
- Wounds and Bleeding
- Fractures
- Strokes, Asthma and Epilepsy
- Casualty Handling Holding skills
- Puncture Wounds
- Head Injuries
- The Effects of Drug Overdose
- Treatment of Drug Overdose
- Burns and Shock

Programme assessments

Assessments for the Terror Threat Awareness course

At the end of the course there is a **20 question** True/False choice examination. Successful candidates will receive a **Skills for Security** accredited certificate.

NB. Certificates normally take **2-3 weeks** to be issued.

You will also be required to complete a Level 1 basic skills test on the day of the course. This test takes around ½ hour. **(We need this to secure our funding)**

Assessments for the First Aid course

Candidates do **not** have to **sit a formal examination** for **the First Aid course**. However they must be able to satisfy the trainer that they can **accurately demonstrate the skills they have been taught**.

Once the candidate has been signed off by the trainer they will receive a HSE approved certificate.

NB. Certificates normally take **2-3 weeks** to be issued.

Course costs

- SFS (Skills for Security) Terror Threat Awareness tuition: **FREE**.
- HSE First Aid tuition: **FREE**.
- Admin charge: **£29.79 per head** (includes handbooks, handouts, accreditations and certification).
- We also require a **£20.00 per head deposit** payable on the enrolment day. **This fee is refundable** on the day of course. **No refunds will be given for non attendance**.

It is the responsibility of the corporate customer to organise:

- The enrolment venue (must be large enough to seat the candidates for 1 - 1½ hours)
- TTA course venue (must be large enough to comfortably seat the candidates for the 6 hours)
- FA course venue (must be large enough to comfortably seat the candidates for 8 hours and have sufficient space for practical first aid)
- Refreshments (tea/coffee and water)
