



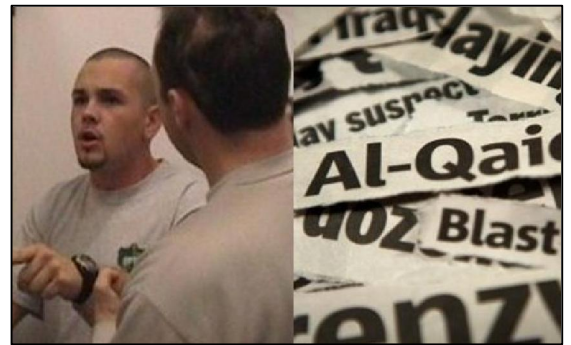

Funding eligibility

Either: UK nationals residing in England for the past 3 years.

Or: Non-EU citizens

a) with proof to remain in England indefinitely. b) residing in England for the past 3 years.

NB. Both a) and b) must apply

To be eligible for funding you must **not** currently hold a **Level 1 literacy** qualification.

NB. Unfortunately we cannot fund people on a student visa.

Terror Threat Awareness (TTA)

With the recent Terror Alert Status in the UK rising to "**SEVERE**", terrorism awareness and prevention, coupled with training is becoming **ever more vital**. We all have a part to play in ensuring that our businesses and working environments can continue to operate with a **greater degree of safety**.

This **course** has been **specifically created** to help meet this need and allow individuals and organisations to better understand their role and what steps they can take in the **fight against terror**.

Physical Intervention

The **SIA endorsed** MAYBO Physical Intervention programme provides candidates with a **wider range of non-violent options** for dealing with the most common scenarios involving **physical contact in pubs and clubs**.

Maybo's unique programme equips candidates with the **necessary skills** to calm a situation, without resorting to the application of **pain techniques to gain the aggressor's compliance**.

These skills are taught in such a way as to allow the candidates to **identify the most suitable option** to either extract themselves or **calm the situation**. They were created so that **both men and women** can confidently apply them in situations to **protect themselves, colleagues and customers**.

Furthermore the entire programme of skills has undergone a **complete expert medical and legal review**.

Prerequisites

To be able to undertake the **Physical Intervention training programme** all candidates **must** have gained a formal **qualification in conflict management**, or successfully have completed the **Maybo SAFERwork** Conflict Management course.

Programme breakdown

This 16 hour programme consists of 2 parts:

- Terror Threat Awareness course
- Physical Intervention course

Terror Threat Awareness course (8 hours)

Each of our few selected trainers are **former members of the Special Forces** and have spent many years serving in conflict countries where terrorism is most prevalent, such as Iraq and Afghanistan.

A key part of the training focuses on examining the **history of terrorism**, as well as the factors that drive people to resort to **terrorist activity**.

The training also examines the steps an individual or organisation can take to attempt to **identify the level of threat they might be facing**, and explores what steps can be undertaken to counteract and **reduce this threat**.

Physical Intervention course (8 hours)

The Physical Intervention programme provides you with a wider range of non-violent options for dealing with the most common scenarios involving physical contact in licensed premises. **It does not offer a technique to cover every possible situation**, but **provides a solid foundation** in terms of knowledge and skills to further reduce risk to customers and staff.

Programme contents

Throughout the Terror Threat Awareness course we will examine the following subjects:

- The definition of the terms '**Terrorism**' and '**Terrorist**'
- The history of terrorism and its effects
- What is an **Improvised Explosive Device**
- Different types of explosive devices and methods terrorists employ
- Counter terror organisations
- Contingency and emergency planning
- **Threat assessment** and management
- Risk reduction measures to **reduce the threat** you face
- The importance of incident management planning
- **Post attack** or incident considerations

Throughout the Physical Intervention course we will examine the following subjects:

- The requirement to use non-physical skills as far as possible
- The law in relation to 'reasonable force' and 'self defence'
- The value of assessing a situation before intervening
- Using physical intervention as a last resort
- Possible medical implications
- The potential **legal implications** of the techniques
- Disengagement techniques
- Escorting and guiding skills
- Holding skills

Programme assessments

Assessments for the Terror Threat Awareness course

At the end of the course there is a **20 question** True/False choice examination. Successful candidates will receive a **Skills for Security** accredited certificate.

NB. Certificates normally take **2-3 weeks** to be issued.

You will also be required to complete a Level 1 basic skills test on the day of the course. This test takes around ½ hour. **(We need this to secure our funding)**

Assessments for the Physical Intervention course

You do **not** have to **sit a formal examination** for **the physical intervention course**. However candidates must be able to satisfy the trainer that they can **accurately demonstrate the skills they have been taught**.

Once the candidate has been signed off by the trainer they will receive a BIIAB/Skills for Security accredited Maybo certificate.

NB. Certificates normally take **2-3 weeks** to be issued.

Course costs

- SFS (Skills for Security) Terror Threat Awareness tuition: **FREE**.
- MAYBO Physical Intervention tuition: **FREE**.
- Admin charge: **£35.00 per head** (includes, handbooks, handouts, accreditations, certification and VAT).
